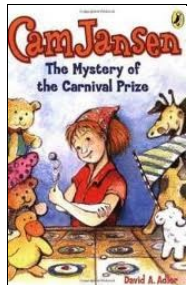

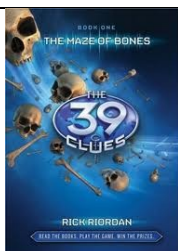
An Enola Holmes Mystery:

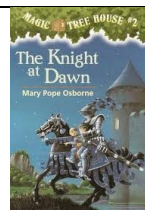
The 39 Clues:

by: Mary Pope Osborne

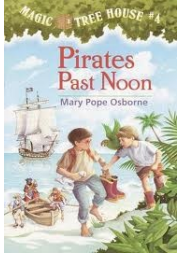

**Review:** Good book! ~Audrey P.~



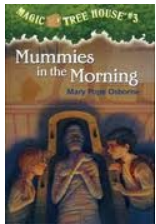
Magic Tree House:

**Review:** Good book! ~Audrey P.~

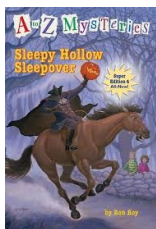


The Coliseum Con
