Standard Cards

Adult Card

There are two ways to apply:

- 1. Stop in at any MHLS library with a photo ID and proof of address.
- 2. Email assistant@redhooklibrary.org to get a card by mail.

Youth Cards: Youth Cards are available for individuals under 18 when a parent or guardian presents ID and co-signs the registration.

Holders of Youth Cards can access the entire collection, including adult materials.

Items checked out on Youth Cards at RHPL are fine free.

Kid Cards

Kid Cards are independent cards, available to anyone under 13 who knows their full name and address.

Kid Cards are limited to a maximum of 3 items and grant access to all online resources (including adult materials) but only juvenile and teen physical items.

Kids Cards are fine-free for items checked out at RHPL.



Teen Access Cards

Young adults ages 13-17 may register independently for Teen Access Cards with a school or other ID. Teen Cards allow young adults to check out 5 items at a time and grant access to the library's juvenile, teen, and adult collections.

Teen Access Cards are fine-free for items checked out at RHPL.

Institutional Cards

Institutions may apply for Library Cards. A designated individual from the institution must be responsible for the account.
